

# HONEY BEE POLLINATOR PROGRAM



The Honey Bee Pollinator Program will provide assistance to farmers who are interested in implementing conservation practices that help improve the health of bees.

Nationwide beekeepers are losing an unprecedented 30-34% of their hives each year, due to loss of wildflowers, inappropriate pesticide use, and colony collapse disorder.

NRCS can provide technical assistance to farmers in the development of a Pollinator Habitat Plan. A Pollinator Habitat Plan will help identify conservation practices that will provide safe and diverse food sources for honey bees within the Upper Peninsula.
