## FORESTERS for ALGER & MARQUETTE COUNTIES

The Forestry Assistance Program of the Alger & Marquette Conservation Districts provides the first professional contact with many landowners who are interested in forest management. Our role is to provide general guidance, basic management planning, and referrals to other public and private resource professionals.

When I encounter a landowner who has a project that could potentially use a consulting forester, I give them our list of consultants and, with their permission, I send a general description of the project to the consultants on the list via an email message, such as this one.

Consultants interested in pursuing the project described below should respond to me by email within two weeks. You may include additional relevant information in your responses or as attachments. Use good judgment in what you include so I don't have to edit. I will forward your e-mail responses, and/or paper documents, to the landowner. I encourage landowners to contact all of the consultants who reply in a timely fashion, but they may delay or change their mind.

I follow-up with landowners to make sure they get the help they need. Give me a call if you want more information on any of the jobs - I usually have digital photographs and notes.

Forest Type(s) –       Northern Hardwoods, with a few acres of transition including Balsam Fir and Spruce, and a few acres of Red and Scotch Pine plantation

Work Needed –         Timber Sale Administration. Small harvest and most likely needs to be bundled with nearby projects. Conifer plantation of about 2 acres is in need of a third row thin and Scotch Pine removal. Remaining hardwood areas are around 110 BA of 10-14" average diameter. Landowner goals are to also clear a 1 acre patch of large hardwoods to expand a wildlife opening, and to subsequently plant the edges with shrubs. Estimated volume of 200 cords, and a good deal of sawtimber in Sugar and Red Maple. Retain any Beech, Yellow Birch and Elm.
